Roses are wonderful and diverse plants for growing in a variety of situations. Knowing which rose is best suited to a specific position can be overwhelming.

We've put together a few suggestions, to give some guidance.

## POTS & CONTAINERS

Growing roses in pots allows you to have fun with your garden, enabling flexibility and experimentation with minimum amount of labour.

### PATIO ROSES

- \* Rosa 'Sweet Dreams'
- \* Rosa 'Sweet Memories'

### SHRUB ROSES

- \* Rosa 'Bonica'
- \* Rosa 'The Fairy'



## WALL | FENCE | ARCH

Bring life to a wall, fence or arch, by creating show-stopping displays with climbers and ramblers.

## SHADED AREAS

Planting roses in shady positions is a great way of brightening up a dull forgotten area of the garden.

## BASIC PLANTING GUIDE



### DIG

Dig a hole about twice the size of the container.



### PLANT

Ensure the base of the plant is at soil level.



### FEED

Choose an appropriate feed, ensuring your plants get off to the best start.
